Re: Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Claims

We are delighted that you have booked a journey with us or are considering it. In assessing whether this is the right experience for you, we ask that you understand and acknowledge that this is a wilderness experience that involves inherent risks and you accept these risks. Participants are strongly encouraged to carefully review this document and all the material provided and to consult directly with us and/or the travel professional handling your booking and gain a full appreciation of the risks, dangers and hazards associated with wilderness travel.

Great River Journey has a wide range of activities and choices of activity level and challenge available for guests of differing ages, agility and interest. Assessing and choosing the activities that are right for a particular guest's ability, level of fitness and interest will be an important part of the relationship between you and your guide but the decision to participate is for the guest to make and for the guest to assume the risk. Illustrated below are only a few examples of the risks, dangers and hazards one may encounter during wilderness travel.

These risks, dangers and hazards include but are not limited to: accidents which occur during transportation to and from wilderness locations; or falling while entering or exiting boats, floatplanes or other vehicles; capsizing or overturning in cold water of canoes, or kayaks (available for use at the option of guests); accidents involving fishing, hiking, backpacking, and climbing (available at the option of the guests), encounters with domestic animals (horses and sled dogs as examples) and wild animals (bears and moose as examples) and encounters with firearms, chemicals and projectiles (used to deter wildlife); accidents involving fires or stoves used around camps; accidents from equipment failure; accidents involving flying by aircraft (including floatplanes) to and from remote locations which may involve inclement weather.

Communication in the wilderness environment is difficult and sometimes limited to satellite phones and radio telephones with intermittent service. In the event of an accident, rescue and medical treatment may not be immediately available. Further risks, dangers and hazards may arise through negligence of other participants or third parties, or employees, agents, guides, or contractor.

I certify that I am physically fit and have not been advised to not participate by a qualified medical professional. In choosing to travel with us and in signing this document, You hereby assume all of the risks and release any and all future claims, including any risks that may arise from negligence or carelessness in any circumstance, including but not limited to those illustrated above. I certify that there are no health-related reasons or problems which preclude my participation. I acknowledge and agree that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form will be relied upon by Great River Journey Inc., its subsidiaries, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents and all others associated therewith.

I hereby consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident, and/or illness.

I understand while participating in this activity, I may be photographed and agree to allow my photo, video, or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose.

This Accident and Release of Liability shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the Laws of the Yukon Territory and the parties irrevocably attorn to the jurisdiction of the courts of the Yukon for all matters related thereto.
